



At William Booth Primary School, we are committed to ensuring all our children leave our school able to swim and to know how to be safe around water. Every year group, from year 1 to year 6, go swimming for a full term. At the end of the term, they are awarded with badges for metres they are able to swim. As some children within the current year 6 cohort are unable to swim 25 metres, we are looking into providing extra swimming lessons to ensure these children are able to swim 25 metres before they leave William Booth.
