



Choose one of these activities to complete after your daily Rock n Read.


<p><b>Simon Summarise</b> Write a ten-word summary of the pages (or book!) that you have just read.</p> 	<p><b>Dear Diary</b> Pretend you are a character in the book you are reading and write a diary entry about an event in the story.</p> 	<p><b>Mirror, Mirror</b> Think about how you are similar to a character in the book. And how you are different. Create a table to show this.</p> 	<p><b>Word Detective</b> Find ten words that you are unsure of the meaning – write them down and find out their meaning.</p> 
<p><b>Incredible Illustration</b> Choose your favourite part of the story you have read and create an illustration for it. You could complete this with pencil, pen, felt tips, paint, collage, the computer...</p> 	<p><b>Penny Prediction</b> If you are starting a new book, before you begin write <b>three</b> predictions about the story that you can make from the front cover.</p> 	<p><b>Front Cover</b> When you finish the book, can you create a different front cover? Remember – don't give the story away!</p> 	<p><b>Act it Out</b> Act out a scene from the book – can someone guess what is happening? You could write a script or even make props!</p> 
<p><b>I Wonder</b> Draw thought bubbles to show what a character may have been thinking about at different events on the page or in the story.</p> 	<p><b>Vocabulary Ninja</b> Find 5 words in the book that are really exciting words. Use them in your own sentence.</p> 	<p><b>Questions Galore</b> Think of ten questions that you want to ask the characters in the book.</p> 	<p><b>GEMStastic</b> Find a part of the story where the main character showed that they used one of their GEMS. Were there any parts of the story where the character needed to use their GEMS more?</p> 
<p><b>Hear, hear</b> Tell someone your favourite part of the book and explain why. Were there any parts that could have been better?</p> 	<p><b>Time to..</b> Create a timeline for the main events of the story (no more than 5).</p> 	<p><b>In the News</b> Write a newspaper report of an event from your book.</p> 	<p><b>Believers</b> Explain how the main character in your story showed our BELIEVE values.</p> <p>B – brave enough to tackle challenges E – excited and motivated to achieve L – leading a healthy and responsible lifestyle I – individually contributing to make a difference E – excellent communicators V – valued and respected members of the community E – expected to aim high</p>



